Links are listed under Mass Times and under section called "Ministerial Schedules / Sign-UP Genius" click on these and scroll down to Sign-up Genius Links. There will be a link for St. Gabriel and one for St. Patrick.

Click on the link and it will take you to the Sign-Up Genius page to sign up for mass and or sign up for a ministerial duty. (You do not need to sign up for both) Sign ups for July have been added to the site. We have added 2 new slots to sign-up for. Lector: 1 person to read both readings at each mass for St. Patrick & St. Gabriel. Collection Counters: 2 people needed to count collections after mass at St. Gabriel on Sunday's and make deposits. You do not have to use the computer. As mass goes back to normal (whenever that may be?) we would resume our regular scheduling for collection counters.

Fr. David will continue to livestream mass on facebook. Sunday's at 9:30 am and Wednesday's at 8:00 am.
